May 21, 1959

"Gypsy" with Ethel Merman, opened on Broadway in New York City for 702 performances. The #1 song was "Kansas City" by Wilbert Harrison, and "Barbie" had just launched onto the American toy market.

In 1959, May 21 fell on a Thursday and it was the date that Sharon Smith joined ABWA. In the 65 years since, Sharon has been awarded Woman of the Year in her different Chapters, she was voted to serve a term as ABWA National District VI Vice-President and is currently the Education Chair for our Trendsetter Chapter.

During our Trendsetter Chapter May 21, 2024 meeting, we celebrated Sharon's 65th Year of Membership. After a thunderous applause and standing ovation, she shared with us how her membership in ABWA began\* and why it continues to this day.
