Women's History Month is an annual declared month that highlights the contributions of women to events in history and contemporary society. It is celebrated during March in the United States, the United Kingdom, and Australia, corresponding with International Women's Day on March 8, and during October in Canada.

Here's some moments in women's history:

- March 31,1776, Abigail Adams wrote to her husband John who was helping in the writing of the Declaration of Independence and cautions, him "Remember the ladies..."
- January 7,1896, Fanny Farmer published her first cookbook in which she standardized cooking measurements.
- March 17,1912, Juliette Gordon Low brought 18 girls together in Savannah, GA, for the first-ever Girl Scout meeting.
- June 10, 1963, the Equal Pay Act was enacted: "To prohibit discrimination based on sex in the payment of wages by employers who are engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce." (PL 88-38).
- April 22, 1970, Earth Day was created to honor Rachel Carson, a woman who changed America and influenced the environmental movement with her book, "Silent Spring".
- September 20, 1973, Billie Jean King defeats Bobby "No-Broad-Can-Beat-Me" Riggs in the battle of the sexes tennis match.
- September 25, 1981, Sandra Day O'Connor is sworn in as the first woman Supreme Court Justice.

Palm Desert, CA – The Trendsetter Chapter of the American Business Women's Association (ABWA) is offering two scholarships worth \$1,000 each, funded through the Stephen Bufton Memorial Educational Fund (SBMEF) to two deserving area student(s).

Each year, local leagues of ABWA provide Stephen Bufton Memorial Scholarships (SBMEF) to female students who will be attending accredited U.S. colleges, universities or community, vocational, technical schools.

Applicants must be citizens of the United States; residents of the Coachella Valley or Imperial County; CA; entering (high school graduating seniors, college freshman, sophomore, etc.) in August 2024 and attending College of the Desert or an accredited Community College, Vocational or Technical School in the Coachella Valley or Imperial County, CA, with a GPA of (2.5- 4.0) or higher.

Applications must be completed by May 15, 2024, at www.sbmef.org. A minimum of three (3) eligible completed applications are required in order for the scholarship to be awarded. Recipient(s) will be notified in July 2024.

SBMEF, ABWA's national educational fund, is one of the most highly respected grant and scholarship funds in the country. For over 70 years, ABWA has helped women achieve their business and professional success through educational scholarships. Since its inception, more than 17,000 women nationwide have been awarded more than 17 million dollars in scholarships.

The Stephen Bufton Memorial Educational Fund is a 501 (c) 3 charitable trust and public foundation. It has the same tax status as public schools, churches and community funds. The fund is listed in the U.S. Internal Revenue Service "Cumulative List of Organizations" described in Section 170(c) of the IRS code of 1954 – revised Oct. 31, 1974.






